- A new member came on who had been diagnosed in April 2018. She presented with a chest lump and went to a breast center. After much testing and 14 biopsies, one was sent to Memorial Sloan Kettering for further testing. She was then seen by Dr. Diamond.
 - She was then started immediately on vemurafenib (V), two in the morning and two in the evening (2+2). After three months the dose was raised to 3+3. This dose caused bad side-effects and the dose was lowered back to the 2+2. She realizes that she may not improve considerably but hopefully she will not get worse.
 - Her husband has early on-set Alzheimer's disease. They went to Orlando last year, but she doesn't know whether they will get to Milan.
- Another member told us about problems between him and his wife, and some new medications. He was diagnosed in 2008 and started V at four a day last April. He found that the side-effects were terrible.
